Course Description: This week-long intensive session will provide a foundation in understanding the characteristics and stages of development associated with second language learning and the implications for teaching American Indian languages. This session is especially recommended for instructors of Native languages seeking the *NM 520 Alternative Certification* or other Native speakers teaching their language. The session will include daily interactive teaching and learning activities, strategies and approaches for developing communicative competence and planning appropriate language curriculum for learners. We will also examine various language related issues including authentic language assessment; programmatic planning, and local Immersion initiatives that have been successful in providing a native language foundation for young children. Participants will have the opportunity to work in their own native language as well as interacting with other Native language speakers in a series of language related projects applicable to their respective language teaching needs.

For optional 3 hrs. of undergraduate course credit, registration as a Non-degree UNM student will be necessary for those who are not already UNM students. Please contact Dr. Sims *beforehand*, if you intend to register for credit so that we may assist you in completing the three-step process. If you have never registered at UNM this process may take some time, so please do not wait until June to start the process. Here are the required steps for your information:

1. First apply and complete a **non-degree UNM admission application** and submit a **\$10 fee to UNM Admissions office** BEFORE attempting to register for the class. You may obtain further information and obtain an application from the UNM Admissions Office by calling 277-2447 or toll free at 1-800-225-5866. Applications can also be downloaded from the UNM website at: <http://apply.unm.edu>
2. Once you are notified by UNM Admissions that you are cleared to register as a non-degree student you will be assigned a personal PIN number. Use this PIN # to register for the class. **Estimate Course Tuition: \$959 for 3 hrs. undergraduate credit + Estimate \$173.34 fee payable to UNM Registrar's Office + \$125.00 assessed to new COE admits, one-time fee. (Tuition Cost determined after May 1st)**
3. Follow the on-line registration directions **precisely** using the I-TEL-UNM system. You will need your PIN #, the Course # (LLSS 449), CRN # (26166) and the Section # (001). These directions are also available through the Admission office. Failure to follow these directions may result in disrupting your registration process. For questions about registering, you may call the Admissions Office directly.

We strongly encourage you to begin the non-degree application process if you want course credit as soon as possible as this may take more than 1-2 weeks for approval and may affect your timely registration.
